

## **Speedy Bargello**

### **Description:**

Have you thought of making a bargello style quilt but were afraid to try? Too confusing? Well, how about trying a Speedy Bargello? We will use a gradation fabric to create a speedy bargello illusion for this quilting project. The instructor will lead you through designing and assembling your quilt that can be used as a wall hanging or small lap quilt. The finished project will be approximately 40" x 40".

### **Supply List:**

Please bring the following:

Basic sewing/quilting supplies

- sewing machine with power cord, foot pedal, thread, pins, etc.
- rotary cutter, large straight ruler (6" x 24" if you have it) and large cutting mat
- iron and portable ironing board (the classroom has these but if you prefer your own, bring it)
- chalk or other temporary fabric marker

Fabric – 1 & ½ yards (or more if you choose) of a gradation style fabric like “Hoffman Waves” found at Sew Much More. You may choose another style of gradation fabric that goes from light to dark or blends multiple colors across the width of the fabric. Check with the instructor if you have questions before the class.

You'll also need quilt batting and backing fabric but will likely need to finish this project at home after the class.
