Classes

Speedy Bargello Bill H Feb 3 9:30am - 4pm \$54
Have you thought of making a bargello style quilt but were afraid to try? Too confusing? Well, how about trying a Speedy Bargello? We will use a gradation fabric to create a speedy bargello illusion for this quilting project. The instructor will lead you through designing and assembling your quilt that can be used as a wall hanging or small lap quilt. The finished project will be approximately 40" x 40".

Birthday Banner Caroline K Feb 5 & 12 10:30am - 2:30pm \$35
Create this adorable Birthday Banner to keep track of how your child, or grandchild has grown from year to year. Each flag has space to add a photo button with their picture from each year. Learn how to create the flags, personalize the name and put it all together.

- Wooly Girls** Carol G Feb 6 9:30am - 1:30pm \$20
Have some fun making the Wooly Girls. Patterns will be given out the day of class. They can be sewn by hand or machine. We will embellish the wool and give each doll their own personality. The doll's head and arms will be jointed. Finished dolls will make you smile.
- Harmonic Convergence Quilt** Bill H Feb 10 9:30am - 4pm \$54
Learn to make a Harmonic Convergence Quilt as created by Ricky Tims. The instructor will lead you through the steps to make a wall size project (approx 32" x 32"). This class is suitable for all levels of quilters including beginners (some quilt piecing basics are preferred but not required). You will likely need to finish your project at home after class.
- Jelly Roll Race** Ann M Feb 11 9:30am - 3:30pm OR May 20 9:30am - 3:30pm \$35
The Jelly Roll Race is a perfect quilt for the very beginner or non-quilter. It goes together in an afternoon and is very forgiving as you practice your strip piecing and quarter inch seam allowance. Ann will show you 3 different ways to make your top and you will be well on your way or even finished by the time you leave class.
- In Depth Ruler Quilting with Westalee Template Sampler** Jo J Feb 13, 20 & 27 OR May 8, 15 & 22 12:30pm-3pm \$75
Class will focus on learning how to use your Template Sampler set and 12" Arc/ Straight edge ruler as you practice Free Motion Ruler Quilting. We will begin by using each template to make a simple motif, then a more challenging design, and finally, a coordinated border or all over pattern. Three 2-1/2 hour class sessions, will allow time to dig into these 6 templates and ruler. Class teaches technique not a specific project. Included photos are for inspiration on what can be done with the templates.
- Beginning Sewing Skill Building** Lynne T Feb 13, 20, 27 & Mar 6 6pm - 8pm OR May 22, Jun 5, 12 & 19 6pm - 8pm \$80
Increase your beginning sewing knowledge with additional skills that are used in sewing - such as gathering, putting in zippers, making a casing, darts and how to follow a pattern. The four projects will be arranged to allow for the gradual addition of terms and skills. The projects are non-size specific. Tips and steps that weren't clear before will suddenly make sense. This is an adult class and the Beginning Sewing is a pre-requisite for this class.
- Upcycled Mittens** Wendy K Feb 15 5:30pm - 8pm \$35
With one to three wool sweaters, you can make several pair of mittens. You will wash them at home to felt them and then sew them into a pair of cozy mittens in class. Most people finish one pair in class! Great for gifts. Wendy's pattern is included in the cost of the class. The only way to get the pattern is by taking the class. The pattern includes child to adult sizes.
- Boho Purse** Zelda Feb 16 10am - 3pm \$45
Create a fabric boho shoulder bag. This bag can be made from upcycled upholstery fabric, cotton or denim. You will learn the basic of sewing a completed shoulder bag, inserting a magnetic snap and boxing corners. You will also be given ideas for embellishing future bags. This class includes the pattern and instructions.
- Reversible Fabric Storage Bucket** Sue T Feb 21 9:30am - 1:30pm \$20
Beginner sergers/sewist, this project is for you. Looking for a cute way to bring a little more organization to your crafty chaos - these fabric buckets are just the thing. They also make great gifts. They are so quick and easy to make using cork fabric.
- Wonky Log Cabin Block** Ann M Feb 22 OR Feb 25 10:30am - 2:30pm \$35
We will use the Wonky Log Cabin block in multiple classes this spring. Sign up for this class to learn how to make the block. You will have the choice of making a table runner that will be close to completed in this class or start making your blocks for the Baubles Quilt or Walk this Way Quilt. The Wonky Log Cabin Block is great for both the precise, linear sewer and those who need a little wiggle room. The helpful ruler from Creative Grids takes all the guess work out of the wonkiness and trimming up after each round means that even if your seam allowances are imperfect, the next row is ready to start back on track and a final trim after the last round means all blocks are the same size so sewing the blocks into a bigger project is a breeze.
- Bread Making Basics** Wendy K Feb 23 5:30pm - 8pm \$40
Wendy has been baking bread for over 30 years. In this class we will explore the basics of bread making, taste 2 different breads and make a dough to take home and bake. Recipes will be shared for all three breads. Students should wear an apron and have hair tied back if appropriate. All materials are included in the price of the class

Free Motion Quilting	Wendy K	Feb 24	10am - 3pm	\$55
Free Motion Class for Beginners and Beyond: This will be a unique opportunity for people who want to learn more about free motion quilting. We will practice different free motion patterns in the morning on quilt sandwiches and in the afternoon we will move to the quilt studio and try out the Bernina sit down machines and the longarms for free motion.				
Kids' Beginning Sewing	Lynne T	Feb 26	12pm - 2:30pm	\$35
This quick class will teach kids aged 8-12 and beyond everything they will need to get started sewing. They will learn how to thread the machine, wind and load the bobbin. They will sew straight lines, corner and make a cute pillowcase. Children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult.

Ever wonder if you can serge? Well you can. This class will teach the basics of serging. If you have not used your serger within a year prior to class, you must have the serger serviced prior to class.				
Accuquilt: Beyond the Basics	Wendy K	Mar 4 OR Mar 11	1pm - 4pm	\$10
Are you a new owner of an AccuQuilt machine? Are you ready for the next step with using the GO! system? This class reviews the basics and moves on to take an in-depth look at using strip, project and specialty dies. You'll learn the ease of die cutting bias binding, sewing curves with pre-cut notches, the speed of cutting complicated appliqué shapes and more highlighted with samples that are sure to leave you inspired! This is a lecture based class so all you need to bring is a pen!				
Candy Leggings and Yoga Pants	Ann M	Mar 5	10:30am - 2:30pm	\$35 + \$25 Kit
Leggings and Yoga pants are a quick and easy project on your serger. We will use the 5 out of 4 Patterns Candy Leggings and Yoga Pants pattern. Options range from simple solid leggings to color blocking and POCKETS.				
T-shirt Quilt	Wendy K	Mar 8 & 22	5:30pm - 8pm	\$45
T-Shirt quilts are a great way to wrap up in the memory of the times and experiences represented in a shirt. Wendy has invented a way to make them without the traditional interfacing. The quilted shirts are then put together with a quilt as you go method. This makes for an easier, more manageable construction method.				
Fractured Quilt	Bill H	Mar 10	9:30am - 4pm	\$54
Learn to make a Fractured Quilt using 4 printed fabric panels that are exactly the same. The results give the illusion of a fractured or double vision image of the panel. It's recommended that you start with a small panel to gain confidence in the fractured piecing process. This class is recommended for those with some quilt piecing experience (we will be sewing narrow seams and pressing seams "open"). You may need to finish your project at home after class.				
ByAnnie - Ultimate Travel Bag 2.0	Lynne T	Mar 12, 26 & Apr 2	11:30am - 2:30pm	\$55
The perfect travel companion, this functional bag includes a comfortable padded adjustable carrying strap and quick-grab side handles, as well as a handy trolley sleeve on back to secure the bag to rolling luggage. Zippered and slip pockets on the front, back, and ends plus a full-height zippered pocket and three more slip pockets inside will keep everything organized and close at hand. Large enough to carry a small sewing machine!

We will go over the basics of stabilizers - what it is, why you need it, what kind you should use for your project. You will learn how to hoop your materials - and what to do if you can't. Then we will get hands on and actually get some stitching done. This is your opportunity to get that embroidery unit out of the box and start having fun with it.

For Cover or 8-thread sergers ONLY. Learn and master a wide assortment of serger techniques while creating this beautiful and unique bag. This bag incorporates ruffles with a decorative rolled hem, belt loops, and cover stitch. All of these serger techniques can be used for a variety of future serger projects. Belt Loop, ruffling and clear foots will be used.

This class is for those youngsters who are interested in continuing their sewing journey. Students must be comfortable operating a sewing machine [threading, winding a bobbin and sewing a consistent seam allowance]. If there's time, we may also make a scrunchie! Kids' Pillowcase class is a pre-requisite for this class. Students will also have the opportunity to try out an overlock machine during the construction of the pajama pants/shorts. Children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult.
