Machine Guide Class Supply List for
B990 & B790 Ultra Sewing, Quilting & Embroidery

Machine Supply List:

- ☐ BERNINA Sewing Machine
- ☐ Power Cord & Foot Control
- ☐ Embroidery Module
- ☐ Giant Hoop
- ☐ Large Hoop
- ☐ Hands-free Knee Lift
- ☐ Extension Table
- ☐ All of your BERNINA feet and the three (3) stitch plates that came with your machine (See side list for the important feet to bring)
- ☐ Black & Yellow Bobbin Cases and at least one (1) Bobbin
- ☐ Oil and Cleaning Brush (that came with your machine)
- ☐ Owner's Manual for your machine

Threads:

- ☐ Good quality all purpose thread (cotton or polyester) – whatever type of thread that you sew with and a color that will show on a dark blue/black fabric & bobbin with same or similar thread (Aurifil, Mettler...)
- ☐ 4 – 5 spools of different color good quality machine embroidery thread (Isacord or Mettler) i.e. Yellow, Red, Black, Purple and one more color

Needles:

- ☐ Universal Needles (size 80/12)
- ☐ Microtex (size 80/12) or Jeans (size 80/12)
- ☐ Embroidery Needles (size 75/11)

Sewing Supplies:

- ☐ Small Scissors and/or Thread Snips
- ☐ Chalk or other marking tool (water soluble or heat erase)
- ☐ 8 – 12" straight edge ruler
- ☐ Longarm thickness straight line Quilting Template/Ruler i.e. Amanda Murphy's Every Angle Template or BERNINA's straight quilting ruler/template (if you have one)

Fabric, Stabilizer & Batting Supplies:

- ☐ Five (5) 10" x 15" dark-color/solidish woven fabric (make sure your thread choices have a high contrast with your fabric choice) – Scraps/left-over fabric is fine
- ☐ Five (5) 10" x 15" sheets of stabilizer – OESD Ultra Clean & Tear would be a good option – I have some stabilizer if you do not have any

BERNINA Feet to bring:

- ☐ #1C
- ☐ #1D
- ☐ #3A Button Hole
- ☐ #18 Button Sew-on (990)
- ☐ #20C / #20D
- ☐ #26 Embroidery
- ☐ #40C Sideways-Motion
- ☐ #97D ¼" Patchwork

Optional Feet to bring:

- ☐ #50 Walking Foot / #50 Wide
- ☐ #72 / #72S Rulerwork

Stitch Plates to bring:

- ☐ 9 mm
- ☐ 5.5 mm
- ☐ 0mm / Cut

- **Quilt Sandwiches** – Left over fabric (top fabric should be a solidish so we can see the stitching) & mid to low-loft batting are ok they just need to be the following sizes:
 - One (1) 18" x 21" (Fat Quarter size) Quilt Sandwich (Fabric, Batting, Fabric)
 - Two (2) 18" x 26" Quilt Sandwiches (Fabric, Batting, Fabric)
